Our personally selected range of single malt and premium Scotch Whiskies

Glenfiddich 12 yo (£2.30)

This is the best known single malt on the market and for good reason. A smooth drinking, high quality Speyside malt with a clean and fruity taste.

Glenmorangie 10 yo (£2.30)

Another well known malt with a rich gold colour and a floral / vanilla flavour. Complex yet light, one of the best selling Highland malts.

The MacAllan 10 yo (£2.30)

With a rich and complex flavour, this Highland malt has many staunch fans. A rich amber in colour from the Jerez oak sherry casks in which it lies for 10 years.

The Glenlivet 12 yo (£2.30)

A deceptively rich yet light Speyside malt with floral and vanilla tones. A soft finish without the “burn” of some whisky, this high quality malt is perfect for malt whisky beginners and connoisseurs alike.

Cragganmore 12 yo (£2.40)

One of the acclaimed “classic malts” collection, this wonderfully complex Speyside malt is a must-try. An initial sweetness leads you into a lightly smoky finish. Every taste will reveal something new.

Auchentoshan 10 yo (£2.30)

A triple-distilled Lowland malt, this is an exceptionally smooth whisky with a delicate and unusually sweet aroma and flavour. There aren't many Lowland malts around, and this is an excellent example.

Jura 10 yo (£2.30)

A deliciously light malt whisky. Typical of island malts it has some peatiness to it but this is subtle and not overpowering. An ideal introduction to Island malts.

Laphroaig 10 yo (£2.30)

One of the best known and best loved Islay malts, this exhibits all the richness and peatiness of that island. The initial smoky aroma is not misleading, the full flavour of the peat-malted barley is what this whisky is famous for.

Lagavulin 16 yo (£2.60)

Our personal favourite and highly recommended. A wonderful smokiness from the peat used on Islay leads you into a rich and intense whisky with all the smoothness of a 16 year old matured in oak. Drink it with respect!

Talisker 10 yo (£2.40)

The only malt distilled on the Isle of Skye, Talisker has won too many awards to count. A light peatiness gives way to a rich and warming finish. Very more-ish!

Tobermory 10 yo (£2.30)

From the only distillery on Mull, this light amber, sweet drinking whisky is unusually (for an island malt) lightly peated. As a result, the delicate smokiness does not overwhelm, leaving a rich smooth finish.
